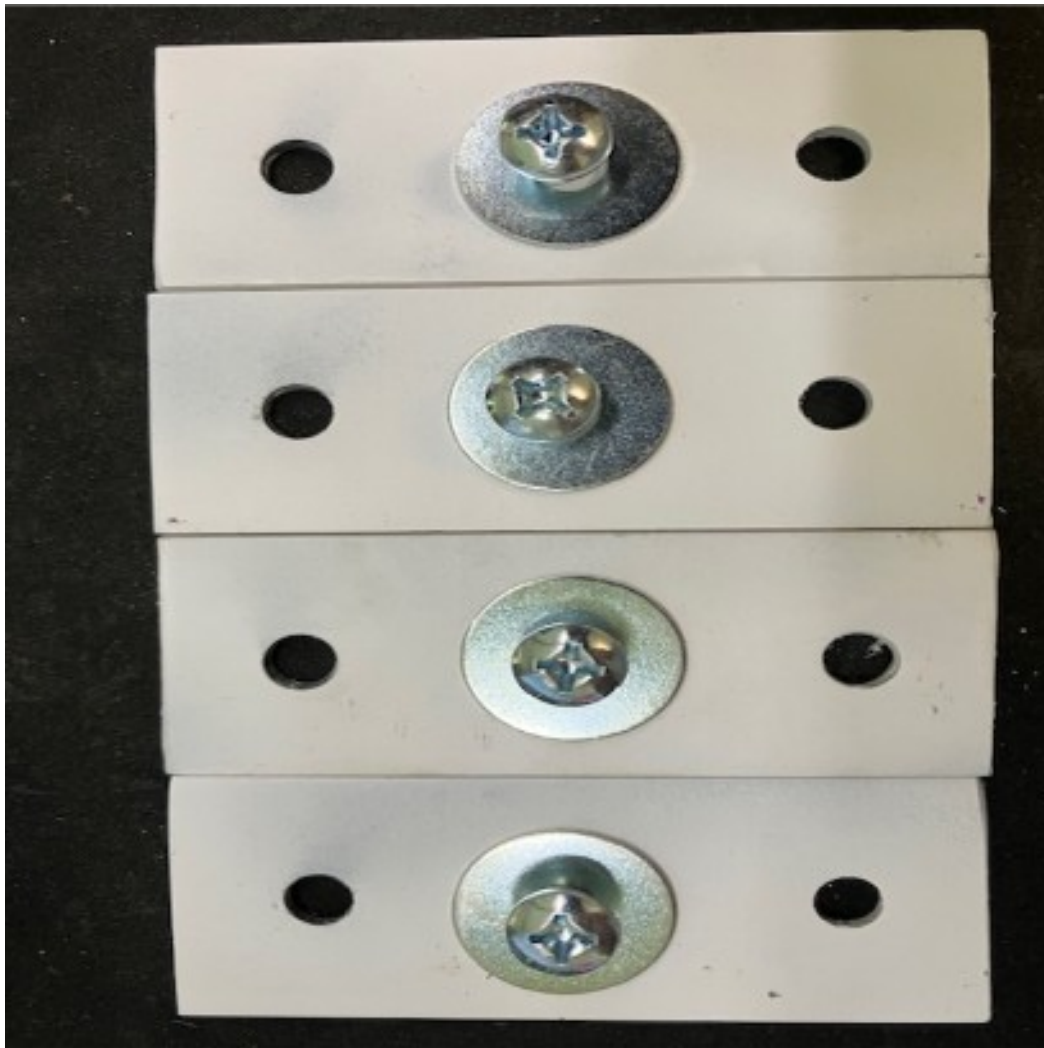


Wall Base Instructions

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How to Install Wall Bases

Wall bases are designed for masonry walls like concrete or brick where the fasteners are best left attached to the wall permanently.

Wall Base



1/2" 1/4x20 Machine Screw



Each wall base has two (5/16") mounting holes for the 1/4" wall hardware, for which the customer is responsible. In the center of each base is a threaded hole for the machine screw and washer shipped with the base. The machine screw requires a Philips screwdriver.

In addition to a screwdriver, you will need a drill, a level and a tape measure to mount the bases. After mounting the base, you may have to drill a shallow hole through the center threaded hole to allow for the depth of the 1/2" machine screw. If you don't do this, the screw may not tighten completely.

- 1) We suggest you mount one base and use a level and tape measure to place the second base. The mounting brackets on the cages are slotted so you don't have to be absolutely perfect in the positioning of the bases.
- 2) Mount the top bases first, then hang the cage or cage section and position the rest of the cage or cage sections where they line up with the mounted sections.
- 3) Mark the positions and remove the cage so that you can mount the bases.
- 4) Mount the cage to the top bases and then the bottom bases.
- 5) Tighten all the screws and you are done.
